





# Get to know the Oldest Canadians

Ever wondered what kind of creatures lived on earth before us humans? Chances are you've heard about mammoths and dinosaurs, but what came before them? Multicellular life forms first appeared on earth between 575 and 542 million years ago. These life forms developed deep under the ocean, and are known as the Ediacaran biota. Fossils of Ediacaran biota can be found all around the world, and the oldest fossils of all can be found in Newfoundland, Canada.

## Who were they?



Ediacarans are hundreds of millions of years older than the oldest dinosaur. From their fossils, we can tell that there were many

different types of Ediacarans that lived together as a community. One type of Ediacaran was *Fractofusus*, an organism that looked like a leafy fern and would have lived attached to the seafloor. *Aspidella teranovica* was another Ediacara that was shaped like a disk. *Aspidella* is the only Ediacaran discovered so far that was able to move around. Squiggly trails next to *Aspidella* fossils indicate that this Ediacaran organism moved by squirming through the mud. *Aspidella* and *Fractofusus* fossils are very common in the Newfoundland fossil beds, but there were many more types of Ediacarans that existed as well.

## How were the fossils made?



two layers of rock. Their bodies eventually decomposed, leaving imprints in the rock beds. Today, we can use these imprints to study life that existed millions of years ago!

You may be wondering how the Ediacarans went from living, moving organisms to imprints on a rock. The Ediacarans in Newfoundland once lived on the soft seafloor of a very deep ocean. When they died, their bodies were pressed into the seafloor. As time passed, more sand and pieces of sediment settled on top of them, trapping the Ediacarans between



## Make your own fossils

If you want a better idea of what the Ediacaran fossils in Newfoundland look like, you can try making your own bed of fossils. Here's how:



### 1 You will need:



Tupperware



Modelling clay



Plaster of Paris



Water



Small plastic toys

2 Cover the bottom of the Tupperware with the modeling clay. Make sure the layer of clay is smooth, and about 2 cm thick. This is like the soft sea floor on which the Ediacarans lived.

3 Press the plastic toys into the clay, then take them out. Try to get deep enough imprints with clean edges. There were lots of different kinds of Ediacarans, so create many different shapes with other small toys or small objects. You could try using a plastic plant for *Fractofusus*, or a coin to look like *Aspidella*.

4 Mix ¼ cup of plaster of Paris with a few teaspoons of water, until it has the consistency of pancake batter.

5 Pour the plaster over the imprints in the clay, then let it dry for 24 hours.

6 Remove the plaster from the Tupperware, and remove the clay from the plaster. You now have your very own bed of Ediacaran fossils!

## What happened to them?

Although we know quite a lot about Ediacarans, this is one question that is still unanswered. Did Ediacarans just disappear? Or did they evolve into other organisms, more like the ones that we see on Earth today? Scientists are examining the Ediacaran's fossils for more clues!




