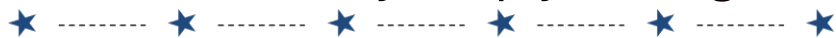


SCHOOL ACCESS TO THESTAR.COM (IP Setup*)

School Boards across Canada can receive a special education rate when they subscribe to school-wide access to thestar.com.

Access will be granted based on the schools IP range(s). The Star will work with the school boards IT team to facilitate the IP setup.

Once the setup is in place, students and faculty who access thestar.com within the school IP range(s), will be able to read Toronto Star content by simply visiting thestar.com.

Internet Protocol Address (IP) setup details and alternative options:

*IP access allows users to read all main sections of thestar.com shown below. However, **some features on our website are not available with IP setup, including: commenting via Conversations, Star Archives and Today's Paper (ePaper) access.** These features require individual user sign in, or a Single Sign-on (SSO) setup. If a school prefers SSO setup, please contact us so we can coordinate authentication testing to ensure compatibility.

Schools with IP setup, will also be granted access to the Star eNewspaper edition (a daily digital replica of the newspaper) via our school portal at: <https://torontostarnie.pressreader.com/toronto-star>.

If an educator accessing thestar.com via their schools IP setup, is interested in commenting on a story via Conversations on thestar.com, they can choose to register on our website using an individual user id (email) and password. There is no additional cost to register. However, to access the school subscription, users must be within the schools IP range.
