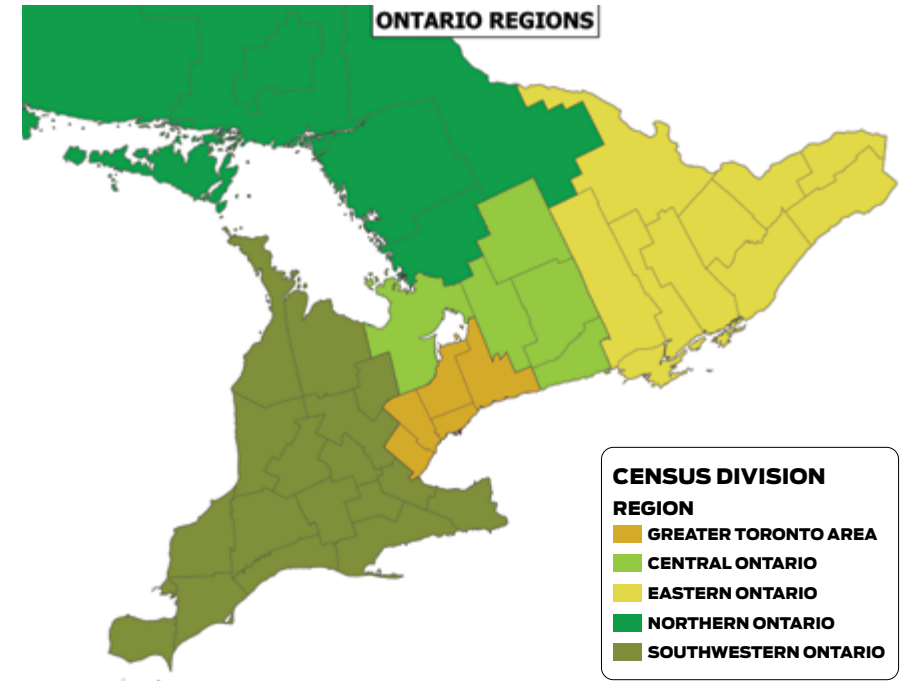

Casa Loma

Canada's Majestic Castle

Completed in 1914, it took 300 men nearly three years to complete the nearly 200,000 square foot castle at a cost \$3,500,000 (at the time). Situated on 5 acres, Casa Loma was the largest private residence in Canada at the time. Sir Henry Pellatt with his wife Lady Mary enjoyed Casa Loma for less than ten years before financial misfortune forced him to abandon his home.

The 98 room castle, designed by architect E.J. Lennox, features secret passageways, elaborately decorated rooms with authentic period furnishings and breathtaking views of Toronto.
